

THE ABBEYDALE GRANGE WAY

Before you enter the room:

- Arrive on time with your planner and all the books and equipment you need for the lesson.
- Line up quietly, if your teacher is not in the room.
- Greet your teacher and each other in a positive way.

When you enter the room:

- Remove your coat, hat and cap immediately.
- Place your bag under the table.
- Get yourself ready to learn by getting out your planner, books and other equipment straight away.

If you are late:

- Fill in the late book.
- Sit down quietly.

The lesson:

- When possible, your teacher will greet you as you enter the room
- In all lessons there will be a Starter Activity for you to begin as soon as you sit down.
- Your teacher will share with you what you should learn and what you will be doing in the lesson - the Aims and Objectives.
- During the lesson, the teacher will give you feedback about your progress.
- Make at least one positive contribution to each lesson.
- You will be set homework regularly. Make sure that you record it in your Planner.
- Towards the end of the lesson, the teacher will check what you have learnt - the plenary.

At the end of the lesson:

- The room must be tidy and all equipment should be returned.
- You will be dismissed by the teacher. Wait until you are told to leave.
- Move on quickly to your next lesson.
- The teacher will give out at least five Prize Draw Slips per lesson, and one postcard per class per week.

Remember:

- The teacher is in charge of what goes on in the lesson.
- Each student contributes to the success of the lesson.
- Co-operate with the teacher to make sure that you can learn.
